Psalm 18:31-36

REMEMBER THAT ONLY THE LORD CAN DO WHAT ONLY THE LORD CAN DO

*“For who is God except the Lord? And who is a rock
except our God?”* Psalm 18:31

It is important to know there is one true God, and He alone
can provide for those who trust Him

“Jehovah” is the root of the Aramaic word “Jeshua,” which
is the name of Jesus

“Who is a rock, except our God?” Psalm 18:31

David was declaring that our God is a life-giving fountain

ALWAYS REMEMBER THAT HE GIVES US STRENGTH FOR THE JOURNEY

*“It is God who arms me with strength, and makes
my way perfect.”* Psalm 18:32

You will never be strong enough on your own

You are going to have to depend upon the source, the
fountain of faith

ALWAYS REMEMBER THAT HE GIVES US STRENGTH FOR THE JOURNEY

He gives you strength

He provides daily direction

He “*makes my way perfect*”

Life may not always be easy, but you can trust the Lord
to guide and to provide

THE LORD WILL CONTINUALLY GIVE YOU WISDOM AND DIRECTION

*“He makes my feet like the feet of a deer, and sets me
on my high place.”* Psalm 18:33

You can be grateful to the Lord; He is still creating surefooted
followers today

He reveals the way through His Word

He gives you strength for the way through His Holy Spirit

He enables you to go the distance, to *“stand on high places”*
