⁵ "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

A GODLY MOTHER'S FAITH MUST BE ROOTED

- What is vitally important is not what you see on the outside, but who she is on the inside
- It is her unseen walk with Jesus that is revealed in the things that her family sees revealed in her daily life

A GODLY MOTHER'S FAITH IS TO BE ORGANIC
