## I Am...The Good Shepherd

Today's Scripture: John 10:14-16

I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. <sup>15</sup> As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. <sup>16</sup> And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd.

"He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearer is silent, so He opened not His mouth." Isaiah 53:7

"Shepherd the flock of God which is among you." I Peter 5:2:

"I am the good shepherd." John 10:11

## THE GOOD SHEPHERD HAS A SPECIAL RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS SHEEP

- The Shepherd reaches out with kindness
  - "Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me." Psalm 23:4
- Three life-changing words
  - God loves you
- Why does He love you? Because you belong to Him
  - *"Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you." I Peter 5:7*
- The Good Shepherd reveals His Familiarity
  - "The sheep hear His voice; He calls His own sheep by name." John 10:3
- The Lord Jesus knows you. He knows everything about you, and He is familiar with all your ways
  - "I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made." Psalm 139:14
  - "You comprehend my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways." Psalm 139:3
- Three life-changing words
  - God loves you
- Four life-changing words
  - He knows your name

- The Good Shepherd displays His Authority
  - "He leads them out." John 10:3
- Only the Shepherd has the knowledge, wisdom and skill to lead the way
- The only way you will get to where you need to go is to trust the Lord's authority over your life
- Three life-changing words
  - God loves you
- Four life-changing words
  - He knows your name
- Five life-changing words
  - He will guide your way

## THE GOOD SHEPHERD WORKS TO ACCOMPLISH HIS WILL FOR HIS SHEEP

- He leads the flock out
  - $\circ$  The sheepfold does not contain the abundance the shepherd has in mind
  - Until you trust Him, you will never experience the abundance that comes from stepping out and following
- He shows the way
  - $\circ$   $\,$  One of the hardest things to learn is to listen to the Lord's voice before you act
  - The second challenge is to act when His leading seems too hard
  - All along the way, nothing is more important than to believe that the Lord knows what He is doing.
- He protects His sheep
  - Never forget that the Lord is there for you and is willing to fight on your behalf
  - "I am the Good Shepherd. The good shepherd gives his life for the sheep." John 10:11
- He brings His flock all the way home
  - *"I have the power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again." John 10:17*
  - In taking His life again, He opened the way to come into His Father's house
